

Licensing Act 2003 - Public Notice of Application

Minor Variation of Premises Licence

Name of Applicant: Boom Battle Bar Cardiff Limited.

Name and Postal address of Premises: Boom Battle Bar, The Old Brewery Quarter, St Mary Street, Cardiff, CF10 1FG.

Proposed variation:

Minor Variation application for the following_

- 1) Update to layout – we propose a variation to the licensing plan to accommodate the inclusion of beer pong. The updated licensing plan also submitted to the licensing authority.

- 2) We also propose the inclusion of additional conditions in our updated licence in pursuance to the variation. This is to ensure the promotion of all four licensing objectives. The new conditions to be included in the updated licence as follows:

All tables intended to be used for 'Beer Pong' must either be (a) booked at reception via a member of staff or (b) via an online booking that will be verified by a member of staff upon entry.

A 'Beer Pong' session will be limited to 45 minutes. Sessions will be limited to one session per group, multiple sessions will not be permitted.

There will be a maximum of 6 persons per 'Beer Pong' table.

All persons participating in 'Beer Pong' will be monitored for behaviour and intoxication levels by trained staff before and during the game.

On days classed as major event days by South Wales Police, 'Beer Pong' tables will not be in use.

There will be no more than 5 'Beer Pong' tables at the premises.

The Licensing Register may be inspected at Licensing, Cardiff Council, County Hall, Cardiff CF10 4UW between 9.00 am and 4.00 pm (Monday to Friday except public holidays).
