

## The County Council Of The City And County Of Cardiff

### Public Spaces Protection Grouped Extension Order (Plasnewydd Group 3) 2024

The County Council of the City and County of Cardiff in exercise of its powers under sections 59, 60, 64 and 72 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policy Act 2014 hereby makes the following Order:

1. The Order shall come into operation on **14/04/2024** and shall have effect for a period of 3 years thereafter, unless revoked, amended or extended by further orders under the Council.
2. The effect of this Order is to impose the existing restrictions over the public rights of way during the periods set out in Schedule 1 below (the “Specified Periods”)
3. The areas subject to the restrictions of this Order are described in Schedule 2 below and are shown as shaded areas on the plans attached to this Order (“the Restricted Areas”).
4. This Order authorises the installation of metal gates at the ends of the Restricted Areas (identified by gate/star symbols on the attached plans), which will give effect to the restrictions.
5. Where a Restricted Area constitutes a through route, the Council is satisfied that a reasonably convenient alternative routes is available to the public.
6. The Council is satisfied that the conditions set out in sections 59, 64 and 72 of the Act have been satisfied and that it is in all the circumstances expedient to make this Order for the purposes of reducing crime and anti-social behaviour in the Restricted Areas.
7. In accordance with section 59 of the Act:
  - a. The Council is satisfied that the following activities have been or are likely to be carried out in the public spaces: Crime and Anti-social behaviour
  - b. This Order is made by the Council because the Council is satisfied on reasonable grounds that activities carried out or are likely to be carried out in the public spaces that form the Restricted Areas; -
    - i. have had or are likely to have a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the localities
    - ii. are or are likely to be persistent or continuing in nature and to be unreasonable and justify the restrictions imposed
8. If any interested person desires to question the validity of this Order on the grounds that the Council had no power to make it or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with in relation to this Order, he or she may apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date on which this Order is made.

9. Those persons described in Schedule 3 shall be exempt from the provisions of this Order.
10. Section 67 of the Act makes it is an offence for a person without reasonable excuse:
- i) to do anything that the person is prohibited from doing by this Order;
  - ii) to fail to comply with a requirement to which the person is subject under this order
- A person guilty of an offence under this section is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3.

### Schedule 1

Restrictions will apply at the following times, for the duration of the Order:

- **Specified Period 1:** At all times
- **Specified Period 2:** between the hours of 5pm to 8am Monday to Thursday, and from 2pm Friday to 8am Monday

### Schedule 2

The following locations are subject to restrictions during the period set out in Schedule1, Specified Period 1:

• PLA 02: Shirley Road / Monthermer Road
• PLA 31(a-b): 10 -18 Gordon Road
• PLA 40: Rear of 5-13 Wordsworth Avenue
• PLA 41: Rear of 10-14 Southey Street
• PLA 60: Dylan Place
• PLA 61: Between 13 Dylan Place and 1-4 Shelley Walk
• PLA 64: Between 15 Shelley Walk & 5 Hardy Place

The following locations are subject to restrictions during the period set out in Schedule1, Specified Period 2:

• PLA 29: Tavistock St / rear 40-50 Bedford St

### Schedule 3

The restrictions referred to in this Order shall not apply to the occupiers of premises adjoining or adjacent to the relevant Restricted Areas, an officer of the Council, the Police, and Fire or Ambulance Services who have cause to use the Restricted Areas in the performance of their statutory powers and duties and any statutory undertaker requiring access to their apparatus.
